From the Pastor

Manna and Miracles

This summer, we have been reading through some of Jesus' parables and a few of his healing and feeding miracles in the gospel of Mark. In all of these readings, Jesus is revealed to us as God's son, and as God. Jesus is the Word who was in the beginning with God and who was God from the beginning (John 1:1). Jesus is the Word who became flesh and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth. (John 1:14) This grace and truth is offered to you each week we celebrate Holy Communion.

I am planning a first communion class this July as we approach six weeks of scriptures about bread. First, Jesus blesses and breaks two loaves of bread, resulting in enough to feed thousands and still have leftovers. Then, Jesus tells us it's not just about performing miracles; he IS the bread of life. Jesus is the living bread that came down from heaven for you. This is nourishment from God, for you. Just like God sent manna from heaven to Moses in the wilderness, Jesus is sent to provide nourishment from God for all of God's children. Jesus said, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats the bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh." (John 6:35, 51)

In our sacrament of Holy Communion, the bread and wine are not just symbols of the presence of Jesus. In this is mystery, but we are promised Jesus is present for us. We are reminded of God's forgiveness and grace. In the night that Jesus was betrayed he took bread and gave thanks and broke it. Then, he gave it to his disciples for them to eat. He commanded them to do this in remembrance of him. So today, as disciples of Christ we continue to remember Jesus' sacrifice for us, even for those who betray him or deny him. We partake in this holy bread in anticipation of that great banquet feast to come. In the bread and wine, we receive the true body and blood of Christ.

As a means of grace, Holy Communion is that Messianic Banquet at which God gives love and forgiveness, faith for our daily work and ministry in the






In Loving Memory....


